

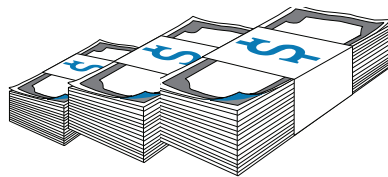
FLORIDA SEA GRANT BY THE NUMBERS

ANNUAL RETURN ON INVESTMENT

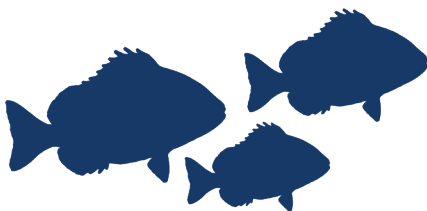


\$1 = \$123
