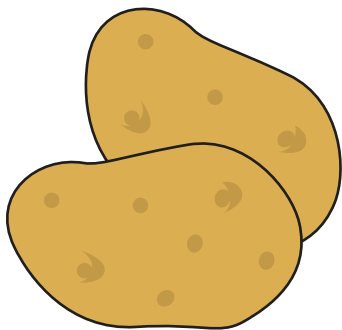
Potatoes have been grown in Florida since the 1890s. The warmer climate in Florida allows potato farmers to grow their crops while it is still too cold in other parts of the country.

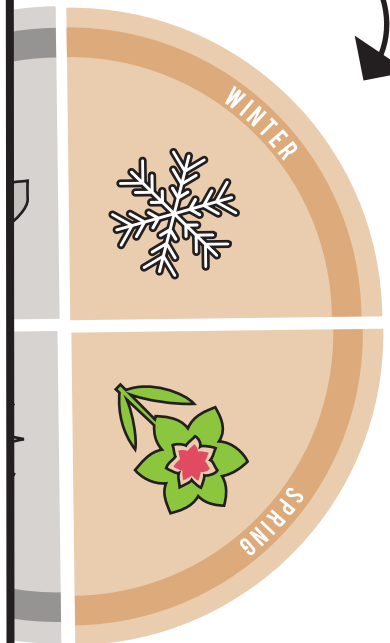
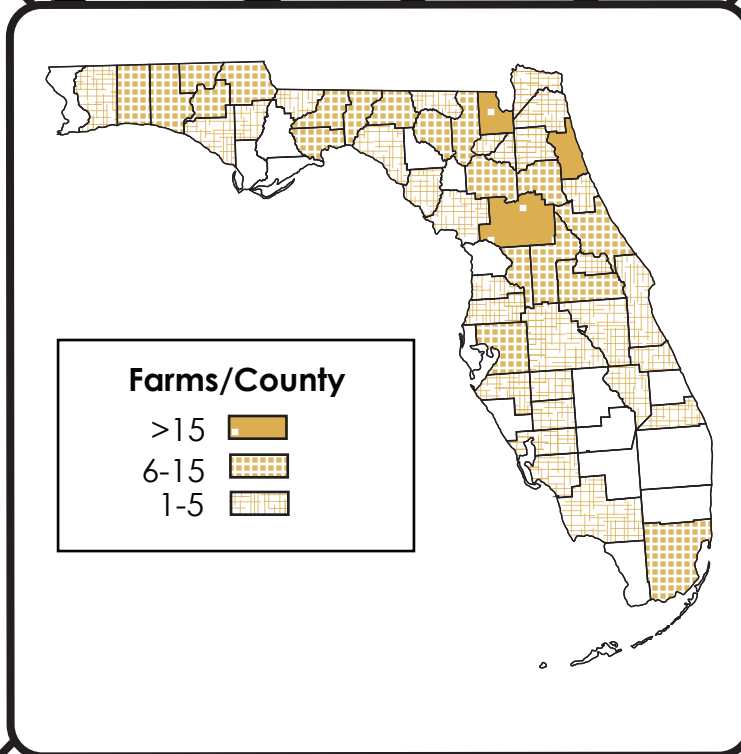
