4-H CAMPS

focus on three essential elements of positive youth development:

Belonging

92% of campers felt "accepted for who I am."

97% of campers agree/strongly agree that counselors, staff, or adult volunteers "showed an interest in me."

Generosity

98% of campers agree/strongly agree that they were encouraged or helped by counselors, staff or volunteers.

79% of campers feel 4-H camp helped them learn to appreciate and care about nature; including plants and animals. Resulting in

67% expressing a desire to "reuse or recycle things before throwing them away"

Independence

89% agree/strongly agree that as a result of attending 4-H camp, campers and counselors learned to "make my own decisions rather than going along with others."

98% of counselors reported that they agree/strongly agree as a result of being a camp counselor they are more likely to "be responsible for my own actions."
